

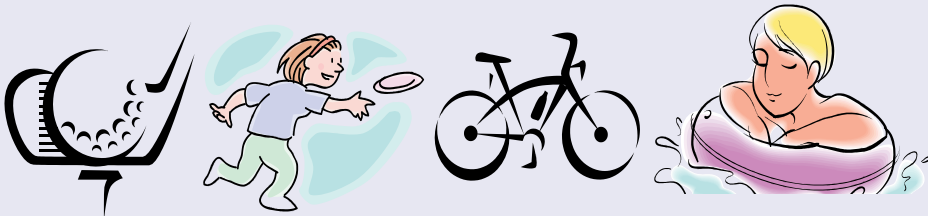
CHILDREN’S YEARLY MEETING

Christian Education Committee is in charge of the programming. Please have your children bring a swimsuit and towel!

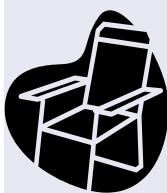
YOUNG FRIENDS
